

VANVIVAHA 2026 – EXHIBITOR TERMS & CONDITIONS

These Terms & Conditions govern participation in **VanVivaha 2026** ("the Exhibition"). Submission of the exhibitor application and/or payment of any participation fee shall constitute acceptance of these Terms & Conditions.

1. Organiser's Rights

The Organiser reserves the right to accept or reject any exhibitor application at its sole discretion without assigning any reason. Acceptance of an application does not create any permanent or future rights for participation.

2. Stall Allocation

- Stall allocation shall be at the sole discretion of the Organiser.
- Stall numbers requested by exhibitors are indicative only and cannot be guaranteed.
- The Organiser reserves the right to relocate or reassign stalls whenever required for operational, safety or commercial reasons.

3. Payment Terms

- Stall booking shall be confirmed only upon receipt of the prescribed booking amount.
- The balance payment must be made as per the payment schedule communicated by the Organiser.
- Delay in payment may result in cancellation of the booking without prior notice.
- All applicable taxes shall be payable by the exhibitor.

4. Cancellation & Refund Policy

- Booking amounts once paid are **non-refundable**.
- If an exhibitor cancels participation, no refund shall be payable.
- Subject to approval by the Organiser, the amount may be adjusted against another VanVivaha event, after deducting applicable administrative charges.
- In case of postponement due to circumstances beyond the Organiser's control, bookings shall remain valid for the rescheduled event and no refund shall be applicable.

5. Stall Usage

- The allotted stall shall only be used for the products or services approved by the Organiser.
- Subletting, sharing, transferring or assigning the stall without prior written approval is strictly prohibited.
- Sale of counterfeit, illegal or prohibited products is not permitted.

6. Setup & Dismantling

- Exhibitors shall complete stall setup and decoration within the timelines communicated by the Organiser.
- Dismantling before the official closing time is strictly prohibited unless specifically authorised.
- Any damages caused during setup or dismantling shall be recovered from the exhibitor.

7. Stall Design

- Stall design must comply with the technical guidelines issued by the Organiser.
- No branding or structure shall extend beyond the allotted space.
- The Organiser reserves the right to require modifications to any stall that may obstruct neighbouring exhibitors or compromise safety.

8. Conduct

Exhibitors shall:

- Maintain professional conduct at all times.
- Ensure courteous behaviour towards visitors, organisers and fellow exhibitors.
- Avoid excessive noise, aggressive marketing or any activity that disrupts the exhibition.

9. Safety & Compliance

- All electrical fittings, equipment and installations must comply with applicable safety standards.
- Fire exits, emergency routes and common areas must remain unobstructed at all times.
- The Organiser may remove any installation considered unsafe.

10. Intellectual Property

The exhibitor warrants that all products, brands, trademarks, logos and promotional materials displayed are lawfully owned or authorised for use. The exhibitor shall indemnify the Organiser against any third-party claims relating to intellectual property infringement.

11. Photography & Media

The Organiser may photograph, film or record the exhibition, including exhibitor stalls, products and representatives, for promotional, marketing, archival and media purposes without any additional consent or compensation.

12. Visitor Data

Visitor information collected through the official VanVivaha registration system shall remain the property of the Organiser. Any sharing of data shall be governed by the Organiser's data-sharing policy and applicable laws.

13. Insurance

Exhibitors are solely responsible for insuring their products, equipment, displays and personnel. The Organiser shall not be liable for any loss, theft, damage or injury occurring during the exhibition.

14. Security

While reasonable security arrangements will be made, the Organiser shall not be responsible for loss or damage to any goods or personal belongings. Exhibitors are advised not to leave valuables unattended.

15. Liability

Participation is entirely at the exhibitor's own risk. The Organiser shall not be liable for any indirect, incidental or consequential losses, including loss of business, profit or reputation.

16. Force Majeure

The Organiser shall not be liable for cancellation, postponement or modification of the event arising from circumstances beyond its reasonable control, including natural disasters, government restrictions, public health emergencies, strikes, war, civil unrest or other force majeure events.

17. Compliance with Laws

Exhibitors shall comply with all applicable laws, regulations, taxation requirements, labour laws, intellectual property laws and any venue-specific rules.

18. Branding & Promotion

The Organiser reserves the right to use the exhibitor's name, logo and company profile in event promotions, website, brochures, social media, advertising and media communications without additional approval.

19. Housekeeping

Exhibitors shall maintain cleanliness within their allotted stall throughout the exhibition and ensure proper disposal of waste.

20. Breach of Terms

In case of any violation of these Terms & Conditions, the Organiser reserves the right to:

- Disconnect utilities.
- Restrict promotional activities.
- Remove prohibited material.
- Close the stall.
- Cancel participation without refund.
- Restrict participation in future VanVivaha events.

21. Dispute Resolution

Any dispute arising from participation in VanVivaha shall first be resolved through mutual discussion. Failing such resolution, the dispute shall be subject to arbitration in accordance with the Arbitration and Conciliation Act, 1996. The courts at Gurugram, Haryana shall have exclusive jurisdiction.

22. Acceptance

Submission of the exhibitor application, execution of the participation agreement and/or payment of any amount shall constitute unconditional acceptance of these Terms & Conditions.

VanVivaha 2026 reserves the right to amend these Terms & Conditions at any time in the interest of safety, efficient event management and the overall success of the exhibition. Any such amendments shall be binding upon all exhibitors.
